

**REMARKS BY THE PRESIDENT OF INDIA  
SHRI RAM NATH KOVIND  
AT THE BANQUET HOSTED IN HIS HONOUR  
BY THE PRESIDENT OF BOLIVIA**

**Santa Cruz, March 29, 2019**

1. I thank you, brother Evo Morales, for your warm words of welcome. Allow me to express my sincere gratitude for the most gracious hospitality accorded to me and my delegation.
